International migrations, globalized mobility and transnational Identities. Migration is both a cause and an outcome of globalization. Global mobility is woven into micro dynamics of family units and local communities and macro architecture of international relations. Mobility appears to be a point of tension between political modernity at the local, national and international scales. First, the course will address the globalized trend of mobility: international, national and regional migration policies, political heritage and new forms of global work division structuring mobility. Second, it will explore individual and collective transnational practices and identities; as well as interactions between the migrants and the home and host societies with a special emphasis on diasporic identities and the construction of transnational social spaces

■授業の到達目標

The objective of the course is to provide students with the intellectual and practical tools necessary for analyzing and understanding socio-economic structures of migration trends, migration politics, and migrants' experiences at various levels (local, national, regional, international, transnational) and in various regions of the world. This course aims to develop students' abilities to write an essay on a precise topic related to the concept of migration or diaspora. The students will work on a case study selected in consultation with the professor, on which they will write a short essay.

■授業の概要と計画

Session 1 Introduction on Global Migration Governance (The UN and the Marrakech Migration Global Compact); Session 2: Migration non-State actors and the dynamics of hospitality; Session 3: Regional migration governance – a Comparison of the Mediterranean and East Asian Areas; Session 4: The migration industry: State agencies, intermediaries, smugglers, traffickers.; Session 5 The Feminization of migrations and labor flexibility; Session 6 Diasporas governance and the migration-development nexus; Session 7 Diasporas and long distance political participation; Session 8 Transnational practices and diaspora ethos: the case of diasporic entrepreneurship

■成績評価方法

Students will have to write an essay on a precise topic, choose with the teacher, using both empirical and theoretical material, drawing upon various sources (academic, institutional) to collect data (qualitative and quantitative). Meaningful participation to class debates and comments on readings will be part of the evaluation.

■成績評価基準
1. Essay on an empirical Case study: 80% of the final grade. 2. Participation in class, readings, etc: 20% of the final grade.
