#### ■授業のテーマ

This is an introductory course focused on current developments in the field of European security, understood both at the integrated level of the EU and at the national level of the member-States. The former European Security and Defence Policy (ESDP), now called EU Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP) has reached its institutional maturity, but proves to be insufficient to address new security issues Europe is facing. Terrorism and migrations especially show that the integrated framework is inoperative or at the very least maladjusted. Bilateral or multilateral collaborations are set in place to compensate the lack of unified (integrated) policies, and some governments are now simply coming back to the realist 'self-help' tradition or claim to be abandoned by their fellow member-States. This course will focus on the intertwined issues of the evolution of Europe's international security issues at the EU level and the persistance of the national security policies. The final exam will be based on the lectures and the readings, in the form of an oral examination.

- a comparative approach to the national security policies and the challenges of European cooperation
- the latest developments in Security studies in a European and Transatlantic perspective.
