Date: February 14th-15th

Venue: at Rokko Hoyoso, Nishinomiya (<u>http://www.rokko-hoyoso.jp/</u>)

Instructors: Students will be taught by 3 instructors (native English speakers)

Fees: Participation and accommodation fees are free for Kobe University students.

Non-Kobe University students have to bear the accommodation fee at their own expense. Meals to be covered by all students.

Detail and objective of the camp:

This camp is an overnight intensive study to acquire some essential knowledge of the EU/Europe through learning in the lectures/seminars. It is also designed for the students to be able to get to know each other and teachers, and familiarise themselves with English through various learning activities including games and entertainment.

2) Academic English Intensive Course

Date: February 19th-23rd

Venue: Frontier Hall for Social Sciences, Rokkodai 1st Campus, Kobe University

Instructors: Students will be taught by a pool of 5 instructors (native English speakers) with ample teaching experience.

Fees: Free

Objective:

The goal for the course is to enable students to prepare for taking English-taught courses of the

KUPES as well as study abroad especially in Europe. You will:

(For first year students: K5)

- Acquire basic knowledge of European Studies prior to the commencement of the KUPES programme from April.
- Familiarise with academic English style.
- Gain academic English skills such as listening strategies and presentations.

(For second year students and above: K1~K4 and M1)

- Broaden knowledge about European studies
- Acquire the interdisciplinary knowledge regarding European studies
- Improve your academic skills such as presentations, literature reviews prior to study in Europe.

Structure:

This intensive course is composed of **lectures and seminars.** In the lectures, students learn basic knowledge of the EU and will be given on the following topics:

- 1) Short introduction to Europe 1
- 2) Short introduction to Europe 2
- 3) Current EU cultural and social development 1
- 4) European architecture
- 5) Current EU cultural and social development 2
